

**PUBLIC NOTIFICATION OF MISCONDUCT HEARING –
PC STEVEN GREEN 17th to 19th MAY 2021**

Name of Officer – Police Constable EA252 Steven Green

The date and time of the hearing – 17th TO 19th May 2021 at 10am

Venue of the hearing - Sussex Police Headquarters, Lewes

PC Green is alleged to have breached the Standard of Professional Behaviour in respect of Authority, Respect and Courtesy. It is alleged that between May 2020 and July 2020 he acted in an inappropriate manner towards Officer A.

It is alleged that his conduct amounts to Gross Misconduct.

Due to restrictions imposed in connection with the COVID-19 pandemic, this Hearing will take place in line with the government social distancing guidelines as well as using video link for remote access.

Owing to government health advice along with the logistical and technical issues arising from the holding of a hearing in this manner, members of the public may not attend in person or observe these proceedings directly. However, in the interests of transparency, accredited members of the media may attend using the video link subject to the following conditions:

- The taking of photographs and the use of film or sound recording equipment during the hearing, except for official use, is prohibited;
- Any accredited member of the media wishing to attend by the video conference link must give notice thereof to Sussex Police Professional Standards Department by completing the online request form by 16.00 on the 11th May 2021;
- Any accredited member of the media attending the hearing by the video conference link must produce valid identification if required to do so; and
- Any accredited member of the media must adhere to reporting restrictions imposed by the Legally Qualified Chair. The Legally Qualified Chair has already prohibited the publication of any matter that could identify the witnesses known as Officer A and Officer B in these proceedings.

Details of the outcome of the proceedings (with written reasons) will be published on the Sussex Police website at the conclusion of the hearing, subject to representations from the parties involved and any redactions on public interest grounds and/or the harm test.
